Harvest Collection – 17th October 2025

We are continuing to support our local **Foodbank at Shore Street Presbyterian Church** as part of our charity work this year. The Foodbank is designed to help individuals and families in crisis, through the provision of emergency food supplies. We have enquired about items that are currently low in stock and have been given the following list:

- Tinned soup and meals/meat (e.g. chicken curry, tuna, ham, chicken)
- Boxes of cereal
- Rice (long grain) and pasta
- Jars – jam, marmalade, honey
- Coffee (small jars)
- Condiments – tomato/brown sauce, gravy granules etc
- Biscuits
- Washing powder, cleaning products and toilet rolls
- Soap, shampoo, shower gel & toothpaste

We will be collecting these non-perishable items in the cloakroom areas week beginning 13th October 2025. All contributions, however small, will be much appreciated. Our donations will be collected on Friday 17th October 2025 by volunteers from the Foodbank. Thank you for your support and kindness.
